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COLORADO PCMH *Best Practice* OF THE YEAR AWARD

The Colorado Academy of Family Physicians announces the annual call for nominees for the Colorado PCMH Best Practice the Year award. All CAFPP members are urged to consider their practices and submit nominations.

Purpose: To encourage Family Physicians to create Medical Homes and to recognize excellent systems of care.

The criteria set forth for the Colorado PCMH of the Year award is as follows:

- A Family Medicine Practice in good standing with the medical and general communities
- Physicians are members of the CAFPP
- Level 2 or 3 NCQA PCC-PCMH certification
- Community involvement and outreach
- Quality improvement initiatives
- Care management and patient education efforts
- Superior outcome data
- Involvement in medical organizations and a commitment to organized medicine and outreach activities such as:
 1. PCMH Speaker's Bureau
 2. Media presentations or articles
 3. Conference lectures
- Provides a credible and admirable PCMH role model
- Willing to share methods & procedures on how Best Practice was achieved

Past nominees may be resubmitted.

Nominations should include:

- Copy of NCQA certification
- 3 Letters of patient support and patient satisfaction surveys
- 2 recommendations of specialist support
- Examples of completed and current QI programs
- Results of Practice measures as relate to 3 important medical conditions
- Demonstration of planned team care
- Summary of outreach activities

Deadline for Nomination: Dec. 1.

Award will be presented at the April CAFP Annual Scientific Conference.
